MERCY HIGH SCHOOL IN BURLINGAME, offers a wonderful summer program for girls entering the 6th through 12th grades in the Fall of 2009. Choose from Tools for School for girls in 6th, 7th and 8th grade for a month of learning, exploring and fun; High School Prep Courses for girls in 6th, 7th, 8th and 9th grade for 4 weeks of classes in a Reading/Writing Seminar (incoming 9th graders only), Basic Arithmetic Skills, Pre-Algebra and Preview of Algebra I; High School Courses for girls in 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th grade with 5 weeks of instruction in Computer Science and/or Algebra I, Geometry I, and Algebra II / Trigonometry; and Summer Sports Camp for girls in 6th, 7th, 8th and 9th grade with four 1 week sessions, full day or half day which include three or four of the following sports: Fitness Training, Tennis, Basketball, Soccer, Volleyball, Swimming, Softball and Lacrosse.

Tools for School (Grades 6 - 8) Incoming as of Fall '09 — 4 weeks

Join us for a month of learning, exploring and FUN!!!

INCOMING 6TH GRADERS: The academic session will allow students to explore areas in reading, writing, math, and study skills. Integrated in this program will be art and creative projects related to academic skills. Students will read volumes 1-3 of *The Chronicles of Narnia*, by C.S. Lewis. This **will** be fun too! Afternoons will include drama, American Sign Language, art, swimming and other recreational activities. The first two Fridays and third Thursday will include off campus field trips.

INCOMING 7TH GRADERS: The academic session will allow students to enhance their academic skills of reading, writing, and math. There will be an emphasis on developing better study habits. Specific exercises in outlining, note-taking, and memory strategies and techniques that will enhance student performance will be an integral part of the program. Students will read volumes 4-7 of *The Chronicles of Narnia*, by C.S. Lewis. This **will** be fun too! Afternoons will include drama, American Sign Language, art, swimming and other recreational

activities. The first two Fridays and third Thursday will include off campus field trips.

INCOMING 8TH GRADERS: The academic session will allow students to explore topics in-depth while enhancing their reading, writing, math and study skills. Strategies for taking high school placement tests will be included. Students will read a book together. The title of the book will be sent out with the confirmation letter. This **will** be fun too! Afternoons will include drama, American Sign Language, art, swimming and other recreational activities. The first two Fridays and third Thursday will include off campus field trips.

High School Prep Courses (Grades 6-9) Incoming as of Fall '09 — 4 weeks

READING/WRITING SEMINAR I (*incoming 9th graders only*): Students will hone the academic skills required for high school success, including organization, listening and study skills, information retention, note-taking strategies, and group work. Specific attention will be paid on further developing reading comprehension and written expression by working through challenging texts and writing assignments.

BASIC ARITHMETIC SKILLS: This course is for the students who need to strengthen their math skills-whole numbers, decimals, fractions, and percents. A variety of problem solving skills will be introduced to help the students become more effective learners.

PRE-ALGEBRA: The course is designed for students who are taking first year Algebra in the fall of 2009. It includes a review of basic

arithmetic skills and provides a study of the foundational concepts of Algebra.

PREVIEW OF ALGEBRA I: This course is designed for students who have a firm grasp of basic arithmetic and pre-algebraic skills, and who will be taking Algebra I in the fall of 2009. Students will explore first year high school math topics, developing stronger critical thinking and problem solving skills. A variety of problem solving skills will be introduced to help the students become more effective learners. A review of foundational skills and procedures will be included.

Dates: June 15 - July 10, 2009 (no classes July 3rd)
Registration Fee: \$75 by May 4th / \$100 after May 4th
Course Fee: \$300 for one course; \$600 for two courses

High School Courses (Grades 9-12) Incoming as of Fall '09 — 5 weeks

ALGEBRA I (5 credits): This course will reinforce topics taught in a first year Algebra Course.

GEOMETRY (5 credits): This course will reinforce topics taught in a Geometry Course.

ALGEBRA II/TRIGONOMETRY (5 credits): This course will reinforce topics in a Algebra II/Trigonometry course.

PRE-CALCULUS HONORS (5 credits): This course is offered to Mercy students enrolled in Honors Integrated Algebra 2/Trigonometry during the current school year and are scheduled to take AP Calculus AB the next year. This accelerated course will include traditional topics covered in a college Pre-calculus course, including an in depth study of trigonometry. *Approval of Math Dept. Chair required.*

COMPUTER SCIENCE I (5 credits): Through a project-based approach students acquire hands-on experience in operating systems, the Internet, word processing, spread sheets, chart/graphing, database and presentation graphics. This course fulfills the Mercy High School graduation requirement for Computer Science.

Summer Sports Camp (Grades 6-9) Incoming as of Fall '09 — four 1 week sessions

THE SUMMER SPORTS CAMP is designed for incoming 6th – 9th grade girls. It provides group instruction in a variety of sports including volleyball, swimming*, basketball, lacrosse, tennis, soccer, softball and fitness training. The camp is dedicated to teaching the fundamentals of each sport, along with teamwork and sportsmanship in a fun, positive environment.

SPORTS CAMP IS OFFERED EITHER FULL DAY (8:30 AM – 3:00 PM) OR HALF DAY (8:30 AM – 11:30 AM OR 12:00 P.M. – 3:00 P.M.)

The morning and afternoon includes three to four sports; sport may vary based on availability of instructors and number of participants.

Fitness Training, Tennis, Soccer, Softball, Volleyball, Basketball, Lacrosse, Swimming

* All swimming will be at Burlingame Aquatic Center, 400 Carolan Ave., due to construction on campus. Students will be transported from Mercy to the Burlingame Aquatic Center and back to Mercy by private bus.

Registration Fee: \$25 per week by May 4th (max \$75) / \$35 per week after May 4th (max \$105)

Note: If enrolling in both Sports Camp and Academics there is only one registration fee of \$75 by May 4th / \$100 after May 4th.

Weekly Fee: \$175 per week for full day sessions (\$140 for holiday week)
\$90 per week for half day sessions (\$70 for holiday week)

Complete Program: \$600 for 4 week full day sessions
\$300 for 4 week half day sessions

Mercy's 2009 Summer School and Sports Camp

To Apply: Complete and return the Application Form along with the \$75 non-refundable registration fee. Confirmation of classes and sports sessions will be mailed by June 1st. Tuition balance is due by June 8th.

Registration: Registration will begin on March 2, 2009 and accepted on a space available basis through Monday, June 15, 2009 the first day of classes, except for Sports Camp. No applications will be accepted after this date. You are encouraged to register early. **Mercy High School reserves the right to cancel any course or sport session if there are not enough students registered.**

Attendance: Due to the nature of summer school and the class time needed for obtaining credit for the class, only two excused or unexcused absences are permitted. Attendance (absences and tardies) can affect a student's grades. **More than two absences will result in a failure for the class;** this includes an instance where a student is sent home for a rule or dress code violation or is suspended. Students in High School Courses (including Computer Science) must be present the last 2 days of Summer School to take finals. Finals will not be given early. All absences should be reported to the Main School Office at (650) 343-3631 before 9:00 a.m. each day the student is not in school.

Regulations: Students attending Mercy's Summer School are expected to follow our school rules. Mercy High School is a closed campus during summer school hours. This means that students are not allowed to leave campus at any time, for any reason during their school day. Students may not go to their cars during breaks without permission.

Dress Code: All students are required to wear appropriate attire. **No pajama attire or slippers, tank tops, spaghetti straps, midriff tops or short shorts** will be permitted. Students must wear shoes and socks. No hats of any type are permitted for academic classes, **however hats are permitted and encouraged for sports camp.** Summer Sports Camp students are encouraged to wear athletic clothes (shorts, t-shirts, hats, tennis shoes.) **The Director of Summer School shall be the final judge of what is considered a dress code violation.**

Refund Policy: When applicable, refunds are handled through the Mercy High School Accounting Office and may take up to five weeks to process. **All registration fees are non-refundable.**
