COMING SOON! We are excited to announce that starting in Fall 2010 Mercy High School, Burlingame will be partnering with mycashlesscampus.com to provide a cashless card system as a new method of payment for your student's on-campus purchases. The **Mercy High School, Burlingame** Prepaid Campus Account will be a more convenient method of payment for parents, and is safer for students and more efficient for our school. This program will reduce or eliminate the number of checks parents need to write and is similar to the prepaid account programs used by many colleges and universities.

With the **Mercy High School, Burlingame** Prepaid Campus Account your student will be able to purchase food in the cafeteria or apparel in the office, plus pay for other campus activities such as athletics, dances and other fees with just the swipe of her student ID card. As a parent, you will be able to fund your child's account conveniently on-line, plus monitor purchases, and set low balance notifications by logging into www.mycashlesscampus.com 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

We believe this pre-paid card program will be a great tool for our families, and for the 2010-2011 academic year participation in the **Mercy High School, Burlingame** Prepaid Campus Account will be *optional*. Each family who chooses to enroll will be pay \$40 to set up the account and mycashlesscampus.com will assess \$2 each time the card is loaded with funds.

Sign ups will begin in early August 2010 and you'll be receiving more details prior to school starting. Once sign ups are available and your account is established, you will be able to load funds at your convenience for the beginning of the school year.
