The fundraising goal for this year's event is \$55,000. All funds raised support our Annual Fund which benefits every student through support of curricular and co-curricular programs. As our only annual student fundraiser we aim for 100% participation by our students.

Each student is expected to raise a minimum of \$55 for the Bowl-A-Thon and turn in their donations by Friday, September 11th. Bowlathon permission slips, signed by parents, must also be returned by that date. Because this is a school sanctioned activity, students who do not participate are expected to report to school on the day of the event.

There are special prizes for various levels of participation. Including:

- \$150 in donations Freshmen and Sophomores can have Winter Formal Day off (1/22); Juniors and Seniors can have Prom Day off (5/13). NOTE: students have until September 25th at 3:00 p.m. to turn in the additional turn in all donations over the minimum \$55.
- Special prizes for Most Sponsorship Money Raised and Top Advisory.
- Earn a chance to spin and win a gift card or Mercy swag at the Bowlathon Prize Wheel during specific lunch periods. More information available in your attached info packet.
- Online donations can be made by clicking here. Friends, relatives, co-workers can support the Bowlathon and, in turn, your daughter with online donations.

Each class will be bowling at a specified time on September 17th (Freshmen 8:30 to 10:15/Sophomores 10:00 to 11:30/Juniors 11:15 to 12:45/Seniors 12:30 to 2:00). Parents are responsible for arranging their daughter's transportation to and from Bel Mateo Bowl.

**DATE:** Thursday, September 17, 2015

**TIME:** 8:30 to 10:15 a.m. Freshmen

There is bowling only on Sept. 17th, no school classes. Go directly to Bel Mateo Bowl for your bowling session. This is a minimum day for all participants. Arrive at your scheduled time, and after your bowling session is finished, you will be dismissed for the day. Parents are responsible for arranging their daughter's transportation to and from Bel Mateo Bowl and each class will bowl at their designated time.

### 3 Simple Steps:

#### 2. Collect the money from your sponsors.

- All sponsors should pledge a flat amount: \$10, \$20, \$25, \$50, \$75, \$100 OR MORE!
- Don't forget to say "THANK YOU!"
- Keep track of who may be making a donation on for you online and provide them with your graduation year and Advisory Room number.

## 3. Fill out a sponsor sheet and turn your money into Advisory starting, Aug 27th, 2015!

Remember to fill out a sponsor sheet with the collected money or online pledge amount in a sealed envelope with your **Name** and **Advisory Room Number** on it and turn it into your Advisor or on non Advisory days to the main office.

## Important Dates

Thurs. Aug 27<sup>th</sup> Students begin bringing money into Advisory. Each time a student turns in money it should be with a filled-out sponsor form in an envelope with their name and Advisory. Advisors will collect money and turn in to the Main Office or on non Advisory days turn in your forms & donations to the main office.

#### A minimum of \$55 is due from every student to participate.

If a student turns in the minimum by Friday Aug. 27<sup>th</sup>, she will earn 1 Bowlathon Prize Wheel Spin at her lunch period on Thursday September 3<sup>rd</sup> and a chance to win a prize!

Sample Prizes will are; Itunes cards, Jamba cards, visa gift cards and Mercy Swag.

## Advisory top Prize!

The Advisory with the highest Bowling score at the Bowl a thon itself will receive \$100 for their Advisory.
