- a. You must earn a **minimum 10 points** from last semester's grades.
  - i. The first 4 points must come from LIST 1 courses
  - ii. The first 7 points (which include the first 4 points described in "a") must be from LISTS I and II
  - iii. The remaining points may come from any LIST (I, II, or III)
- b. You may not use more than 5 courses to qualify
- c. No CSF points are given for physical education, course taken in lieu of physical education, subjects repeated to improve a grade, courses involving clerking and office/ teaching assisting, and courses taken on a pass/fail basis
- d. CSF points are granted as follows:
  - i. For an A in a....
    - 1. Regular Course = 3 points
    - 2. Honors course = 4 points \*
  - ii. For a B in a ...
    - 1. Regular Course = 1 points
    - 2. Honors Course = 2 points \*

\*Please note that you may only earn up to a maximum of 2 additional points for Honors/ AP Classes (for example, if you have 3 A's in honors courses, you may only earn the additional point for two of the classes, not all three.)
