This October, in honor of National Breast Cancer Awareness month, Mercy will be educating students and fundraising for Breast Cancer. We will also be participating in our annual haircutting assembly, the Think Pink Rally, benefiting the “Locks of Love” providing hairpieces to financially disadvantaged children in the United States and Canada under age 21 suffering from medical hair loss from any diagnosis. The prostheses we provide help to restore their self-esteem and their confidence, enabling them to face the world and their peers. Hair will also be donated to “Pantene, Beautiful Lengths “ program, benefitting women who have lost their hair as a result of chemotherapy. Our assembly will be held here at Mercy on Thursday, October 8th.

Participants in “hair donation” will be contributing to one of the two foundations depending on the length/amount of hair donated. The ponytail length for cutting must be at least 8 inches for the Beautiful Lengths program and at least 10 inches for the Locks of Love program.
